If you know of anyone who is new to the area, has a child entering 1st grade or higher, or has expressed an interest in 4-H, please encourage them to attend this meeting.

Your username is an email address.

ALL 4-H members **MUST** re-enroll online in 4-H Connect each year. If you do not re-enroll, then you will not be considered an active 4-H member or volunteer and your contact information might be dropped from the weekly e-mail blast and newsletter distribution lists. Texas 4-H charges an annual enrollment fee of \$20.00 per member (3rd grade and up), and this fee increases to \$25.00/ member after October 31, 2016.

4-H members in the 1st or 2nd grade will not be charged an annual enrollment fee. All adult volunteers will be charged a \$5.00 enrollment fee, and this will include a background screening if you have not had one in the previous three years.



TIPS FOR 2016-2017 ENROLLMENT IN 4-H CONNECT

- If you enrolled in 4-H Connect last year or even several years prior, then you already have an account, and you don't need to create a new one! 4-H Connect saves your information from year to year, and you just need to make sure that it is updated and that you submit a payment for this year.

- If you need to add a family member, just sign into your family's account and look at the top right-hand side of the screen for the section "Add A New Family Member".
- If you forgot your password or you are having a hard time getting into your account, you might be entering the wrong e-mail address. You can re-set your password in the system if you forgot your password.
- There is no annual enrollment fee for 4-H Clover Kids. Clover kids are 4-H members who are in the 1st or 2nd grade.
- Please check to make sure that the correct school is listed for each 4-H member.**
- Check to make sure that the birth date is correct for each 4-H member. Many families have a tendency to enter "2016" as the birth year instead of the actual birth year.
- Check to make sure that the correct gender has been entered for each person in your family. There are many people in our county who are listed as the wrong gender.



I'M A 4-H PARENT OR ADULT VOLUNTEER, DO I NEED TO ENROLL AS A VOLUNTEER IN 4-H CONNECT?

Club managers, project leaders, coaches, and all other adults who might be transporting 4-H members in their personal vehicles this next year **MUST** enroll and will be assessed an annual \$5.00 fee to cover background screenings. This fee can be paid online through 4H Connect with a credit card.

NEW THIS YEAR: Adult Volunteers must also complete 2 online trainings during the annual enrollment process in 4-H Connect titled "Texas 4-H Volunteer Training" and "Ensuring a Safe Environment". These online trainings take approximately 15 minutes per training. You will see them whenever you work on your enrollment, so plan to take 45 minutes to complete the trainings and the enrollment process for adults.

Why do I need to choose a community club to join? What clubs are available in Gillespie County?

Community clubs are the heart of the 4-H experience. Youth learn many lifelong skills by participating in club meetings. Older youth members serve as officers and learn skills related to their elected positions and teach younger members to follow in their footsteps. Most youth are able to serve as an officer multiple times throughout their 4-H career due to the size of the clubs in our county.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

The Gillespie County 4-H program and the Texas A&M Agrilife Extension Service supports the Texas Education Code requirements to be labelled as an official "extracurricular activity".

Please keep in mind that in all 4-H competitive events 4-H members must be eligible to compete. This applies regardless of the day or time during the week the event is held. Eligibility requirements apply to all 4-H members whether they are enrolled in public, private or home school. Eligibility is determined by the school, not the county Extension agent. Parents should address questions about a student's eligibility to the school.

GILLESPIE COUNTY YOUTH LIVESTOCK SHOW CLUB ATTENDANCE RULE

Just a reminder for those who are planning on exhibiting animals at the 2017 Gillespie County Youth Livestock Show – please take note of the rules! You must attend a minimum of 5 4-H Club Meetings from September 2016 to August 2017 in order to be eligible to show.

*If you were a new member in Sept 2016, you must attend ½ of the meetings from the time you enroll through December 2016.

*If you joined sometime after September 2016, but before September 2017, you must attend ½ of the meetings from the time you join until August 2017.

COUNTY & MAJOR SHOW BROILER ORDERS

Order deadline: Friday, October 7th

COUNTY BROILERS

Cost: \$2.00/chick (must order in increments of 25, 50, or 75)

If you are planning to show broilers at the Gillespie County Youth Livestock Show, then you must place your order by **Friday, October 7th**. County broilers are expected to arrive the week after Thanksgiving.

SAN ANTONIO, HOUSTON/AUSTIN BROILERS

Cost: \$1.50 per chick (must be ordered in increments of 25)

If you are planning to show broilers at the San Antonio Livestock Show or Houston/Rodeo Austin, this is a separate order. Major show broilers must be ordered by **Friday, October 7th**.

NOTE: HydroAid gel packs are included with the price of the broilers.

Birds must be ordered in increments of 25. Please come by the Extension Office at 95 Frederick Rd. in Fredericksburg to place your broiler orders. Bird will not be ordered without payment. We can accept check or exact cash payments only. We cannot accept credit cards.



HEIFER VALIDATION ORDERS FOR 2017 SHOWS OR CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP

Deadline to order validation paperwork is **Friday, September 9th**

Cost: will be collected at physical validation in October

NOTE: We will need the actual heifer registration papers at the time of validation. **The original registration papers must be in exhibitor's name by November 1, 2016.**

If you are planning to show a heifer at a major stock show, then that heifer must be validated. Also, if a heifer has been validated previously, and the ownership has changed, then it must be re-validated. **If you are planning to show a heifer that has been previously validated and the ownership or breed has not changed, then she will NOT need to be validated again. If the ownership or the breed changes, then the heifer will need to be re-validated.**

What is Quality Counts?

Quality Counts is an online program designed to teach youth to have high standards in caring for their livestock. The program focuses on displaying good character while working with livestock. Once the program is completed by passing either the junior level or senior level exam, the participant will receive a Quality Counts verification number. **This number is required for ALL stock show entries (county AND major stock shows).**

Where do I go to take the Quality Counts Exam?

The link is agrilife.org/qualitycounts/. Once you are on the website, click on the word "Verification" and click on "Take the test and become Verified". If you are only showing through 4-H, then click on "4-H" icon. If you are showing through 4-H and FFA, then click on the "4-H and FFA" icon. Enter your basic information, and make sure that you enter that you are showing in Gillespie County!!! If you do not enter Gillespie County, we will not be able to retrieve your Quality Counts Number! Then, begin answering each question on the test and submit your exam when finished. We will be able to see if you have completed the exam, and it will not be necessary for you to bring in a copy of your quality counts certificate.

My 4-H member has taken the quality counts exam previously; does he/she have to take it again?

It depends on the exhibitor's age. Exhibitors must take and pass the junior level exam **once** until age 14 (as of August 31, 2016). Once an exhibitor turns 14, then he/she must take and pass the senior level exam **one time**. It is not necessary to take the exam again each year unless the member is moving from the junior level to the senior level.

CALF SCRAMBLES

A calf scramble is a competition held at most major stock shows where an exhibitor attempts to catch and halter a calf. If an exhibitor is successful, the stock show will award a certain amount of money to the competitor to use towards the purchase of an animal to show at that same stock show the following year. Each major stock show does their calf scramble competitions a little differently, so it is best to view each show website for specific rules and dates. Most shows will release calf scramble dates, rules, and entry forms on October 1, 2016, and we will try and keep you updated as well
