Who is eligible?

- Any high school senior graduating in spring 2024 who is a legal U.S. resident and currently attends school in Gillespie County
- Current Gillespie County 4-H member
- Seniors planning to further their education at an accredited two or four-year college or university or technical school.

What are the requirements?

- A completed and signed EEA scholarship application.
- 5x7 color photo of applicant
- Attend EEA Spring Luncheon – May 2, 2024

When is the deadline?

The scholarship application deadline is February 15, 2024

How do you apply?

What happens if you are selected to receive a scholarship?

- Information about the dissemination of funds will be included in the award notification.
- You must enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study no later than the fall term of the 2024 school year at an accredited two or four-year college or university or technical school. If you do not, then you forfeit your scholarship, and an alternate recipient will be selected.
- Scholarship money must be used to cover the costs of tuition, fees, or books. Checks will be mailed to individual winners, not to their college or university.
