



PROTECT TEXAS PREVENT WILDFIRES

SAFE DEBRIS BURNING

Escaped debris burning is one of the leading causes of wildfires in Texas.

-  Plan time to stay with your fire until it is out cold.
-  Always follow local outdoor burning regulations. Check with local officials for restrictions or burn bans.
-  Delay burning if the weather conditions are, or will be, hot, dry and windy.
-  Clear vegetation or other burnable material at least 10 feet around the burn site. Avoid any overhead obstructions and have tools and a water source on hand before beginning.
